LOD Uniform... Please refer to the website to make sure all your uniform is current and correct for the new level of your child. Some levels will be going into new uniforms.

- **GRADE 1 BALLET:** students move from pink into burgundy leotard & will now also need a character skirt & shoes (low heeled).
- GRADE 3 BALLET: students may now wear the Cuban heeled character shoes.
- DANCE SHORTS & LOD SINGLETS: We keep stock of these items for tap, contemporary, commercial & hip hop, and are available for order through your portal.
- NAVY LEOTARDS/BLACK BOOTLEGS: Some stock is available for order through the portal, otherwise we will be doing an order, which you can do at the Buy & Sell (or email us if you can't attend).
- LET'S DANCE COMBO CLASS: We have some stock available through the portal, and will do another order also at the Buy and Sell. (again, please email us if you can't attend).

A reminder too, particularly in these warmer months, that students should remember to wear deodorant to class (As a rule of thumb this applies to all students 10+). Jazz Students can wear dance shorts. Bring a bottle of water to class.

Graded Ballet Exams... After the success of last year's Graded Ballet Exams at the end of Term 3, we will continue to run our Ballet year in this way. This means the Graded Ballet holiday programme will be held together with the Jazz and Tap in week 2 of the July School Holidays.

Production 2019... We have dates for the end of year show this year. It will be Friday 6, Saturday 7 & Sunday 8 Dec (end of week 8). We are in the theatre with rehearsals from Thursday 5 Dec with 2 Sunday rehearsals at the Studio preceding that Sunday 24 Nov & 1 Dec.

Production 2018... Thank you again to everyone for your help in making the 2018 Production such a success, and a big thank you as always to Infinite Monkeys & Stellar Studios for their continued support of the Studio.

Private Lessons and Studio Hire... With a little more flexibility in the timetable, we can offer more availability for both private lessons and personal studio hire. Private lessons are \$35 per 1/2hr, \$45 per 3/4hr or \$70 per hr, with discounted rate for multiple bookings. Students can hire a Studio for \$10 per hour during studio opening times, or \$30 outside of business hours.

Allergies... In all our classes we have children who suffer from food allergies, (nuts, eggs, wheat, Kiwifruit to name a few) so please just a gentle reminder to take this into consideration when packing after school snacks.

• 2nd Hand Uniform Buy & Sell Day on Sat 16 February 9am - 11.00am. We will continue the very successful Buy & Sell day for "near new" 2nd hand uniform. We will be collecting gear during the first week of classes so please bring anything you wish to sell to your first class. We are happy for your child to wear appropriate non-uniform gear during these weeks if you are wishing to check out the buy/sell before purchasing uniform. Apologies to the Saturday parents as you will need to bring any gear into the Studio before your first day of classes.

What To Do If You Are Selling: PLACE EACH ITEM IN A SEPARATE PLASTIC BAG WITH YOUR NAME & THE SIZE ON IT. We will price all gear, & anything that doesn't sell we will pass back to the owners after the sale. You are then welcome to list anything in the buy & sell folder in the reception area. We charge a handling fee of \$5 per item sold. Please note we will only take goods that are of good quality, and not overly worn or faded.

What To Do If You Are Buying: Come along with your child on Sat 16 Feb (wk 1 of term) 9am – 11am PLEASE BRING CASH. As a general guideline, prices will range from \$10 for smaller items to \$40 for larger items. We will also have some LOD gear available for purchase, and will be fitting any students who wish to order a navy leotard.
